Ammunition must be appropriate for rifle used (see "Classification" below). Tracer/Incendiary Ammunition is not allowed.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all competitors, **membership in the NRA is NOT required**.

ENTRIES:

Individuals: All entries should be mailed so as to reach Dennis Casey no later than 8 August 2016. Entries can be made by using a SR-1, accompanied by check or money order, or by e-mailing Dennis Casey. Be sure to include your correct NRA classification and NRA membership number if you have one. If you are not a NRA member, a number will be assigned you, for classification purposes only.

Advanced entry is requested. Post entries and walk-on's will be accepted provided no special squadding or relays are required.

Entries Close: Individual Match entries must be received no later than Monday preceding the opening date of the tournament.

Entries Limited: Entries are limited to sixty (60) competitors.

FEES:

The Colorado State Long Range Rifle Championship is a two-day course of fire as specified below:

- CRC members \$35
- Non CRC members \$45

(includes NRA individual fees)

Post Entry Fee: \$5

TIME OF FIRING: Firing will commence each day at 8:00 AM

TARGET: NRA Official Targets will be used (Section 4, NRA Rules).

CHALLENGES: A challenge fee of \$1.00 will be charged for each challenge made. (NRA Rule Book section 16).

SQUADDING: All matches will be squadded. Squadding will be done by the Statistical Office. Competitors are responsible for proof of classification. Squadding information for team matches will be announced on range. A competitor who fails to present himself at the proper firing point when his relay is called may lose his right to compete in that event.

CLASSIFICATION: The NRA classification system will be used in all matches. **NRA classification cards may be checked by the Statistical Officer.** Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class. Rule 19.6 - Assigned Classification, or 19.2 - Temporary Classification, may be used.

Categories: The categories and rifles allowed for these matches are as follows:

- 1) Palma Rifle (NRA High Power Rifle Rule 3.3.1)
- 2) F- Open Rifle [NRA High Power Rifle Rule 3.4(a)]
- 3) F- Target Rifle [NRA High Power Rifle Rule 3.4(b)].

AWARDS:

Award Schedule: Individual Grand Aggregate winners in the Palma, F-TR, and F-Open categories will have their names engraved on the appropriate Colorado State High Power Rifle Long Range Trophies (provided entries warrant).

Cash prizes will be awarded for both Palma matches, the 1000 yard match, and the Grand Aggregate, as warranted by entries.

Approximately fifty percent of the entry fees (minus NRA fees) will be returned to the competitors in the form of cash prizes.

The number of competitors in a class in a category will determine the amount of awards as above. Five competitors establish a class in a category and 1st place, 10 competitors 2nd place, 15 competitors, 3rd etc.
